

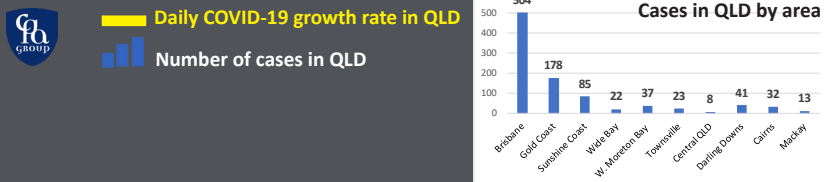
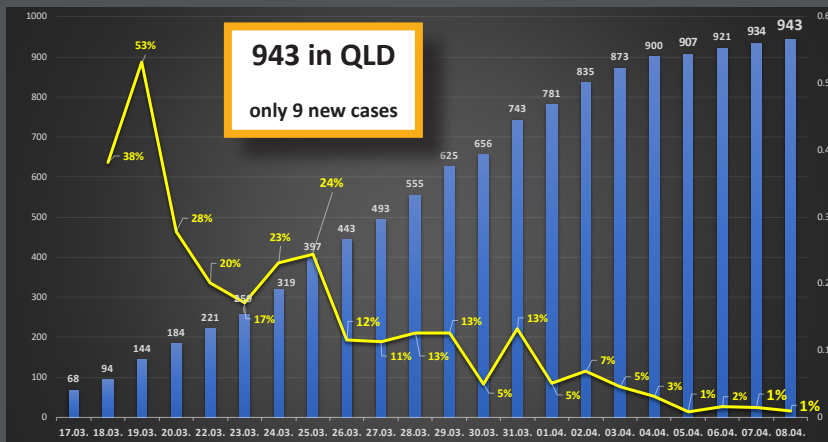

6,013 Total cases confirmed

50 Deaths confirmed

Latest updates:

- QLD 943, NSW 2734, ACT 99, NT 27, SA 420, TAS 97, VIC 1,212, WA 481.
- So far, 319,368 tests conducted in Australia. Only 1.9% turned out positive.
- The recovery ratio is currently 46.8%.
- An analysis of the latest government data on coronavirus shows locally acquired infections have outnumbered infections acquired overseas for the past four days. The analysis also shows the growth in locally acquired cases is slowing in New South Wales and Victoria, the two states for which detailed data is available.
- The Australian Parliament has passed the \$130 billion Job-Keeper wage subsidy scheme. More than 730,000 businesses have signed up for the scheme, which is designed to keep millions of employees on payroll.
- Border Force gave the green light for the troubled Ruby Princess to dock in Sydney, official sources have revealed. The NSW Police criminal investigation into the fiasco, named Strike Force Bask, has begun.

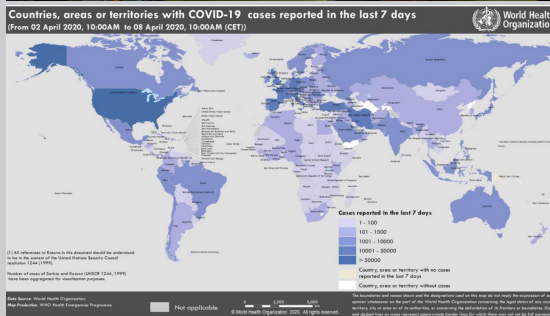
