### Latest updates:

- The NSW-Victoria border will close at 12.01am tomorrow. A travel ban is already in place for residents of Melbourne. Returning NSW residents will need to self-isolate for 14 days.
- Metropolitan Melbourne and Mitchell Shire Council will return to stage three restrictions for six weeks as of midnight Wednesday, Premier Daniel Andrews has announced.
- Residents of the nine public housing towers under strict lockdown in Melbourne's inner north have received an apology from the department after supplies they were provided with were inadequate.
- The Australian coronavirus death toll rose to 106 yesterday following the deaths of two Victorian men: one in his 60s and one in his 90s.



## What is a COVID-19 Penalty Unit worth in Queensland?

### PENALTIES

A person to whom the direction applies commits an offence if the person fails, without reasonable excuse, to comply with the direction.

Section 362D of the Public Health Act 2005 provides: Failure to comply with public health directions

- A person to whom a public health direction applies must comply with the direction unless the person has a reasonable excuse.
- Maximum penalty—100 penalty units.

A penalty unit is currently **\$133.45** in Queensland

### Changes to recording of contact-tracing

Businesses that are obliged to comply with Contact-Tracing requirements must now keep contact details for at least 56 days on record.
